## Admission Procedures

1. The student fills out an application for initial admission on the website at the following link:

2. The Admission Department reviews the application and makes a comparison between applicants who meet the admission requirements for the specialization and sends a SMS to those initially accepted to attend to the Admission Department and bring the required documents and certificates.
3. The student attends and brings the required documents and certificates, fills out a paper acceptance file, and request an electronic final acceptance on the electronic portal of the academic system.
4. Personal interview.
5. Pay the acceptance fee of 2500 riyals, which is calculated as part of the fees for the first semester.
6. Medical examination in a hospital.
7. Handing over the file to the Department of Admission and Certificates and the receipt of payment.
8. Extracting a university number for the student through the Admission Department.
9. The student goes to the department to download a study schedule and make an equivalency for the previous courses, if any.



## Conditions for admission of High school students.

### General Terms:

1. The student must have a high school or its equivalent from inside or outside the kingdom.
2. The student must successfully pass any test or personal interview that the College Council sees.
3. The student must be medically fit.
4. The student must obtain approval to study from his employer, if he works in any government or private institution.
5. The student must not have been dismissed from any other university or college for disciplinary terms.
6. Submit the required documents specified by the College Admission Department and pay the registration fees.
7. Admission is made through a comparison between students according to the rates and conditions required to enroll in the major.
8. The student must have a high school within five years ((This condition can be excluded if the remaining conditions are met except for the Dentistry specialization).

**Note:** The above conditions are the minimum initial admission, noting that the final acceptance is by comparison according to the number of available seats and according to the highest average.

### Criteria for accepting high school students in Dentistry Major:

#### New students

1. The weighted percentage should not be less than 70%, broken down as follows: [30% general secondary, 40% achievement, 30% abilities] (provided that the achievement test percentage is not less than 60%).
2. That no more than five years have passed since obtaining the secondary school.

### Students transferred from another university to Dentistry at Buraydah Colleges:

In addition to the above conditions, "Passing the first year with a grade point average of no less than very good (3.75 out of 5).

#### Required Documents:

1. Original high school transcript certificate or its equivalent
2. A copy of the civil Id or residence card and passport for non-Saudis with the original residence for matching that are recent and clear
3. A copy of the measurement capabilities test
4. A copy of the achievement test
5. Two recent personal photos (boys only).



## Conditions for accepting postgraduate diploma graduates

### General Terms:

1. To have a high school or equivalent from inside or outside the kingdom.
2. Be of good conduct.
3. The diploma should not have passed for more than five years (this condition can be excluded if the remaining conditions are met).
4. The student's general average in the diploma should not be less than good.
5. The desired major should be an extension of the student's major in diploma.
6. The student must pass one of the following standardized tests of English language "for health specialties only":
  - TOEFL Paper-Based (PBT) score of at least 425.
  - TOEFL Computer-Based (CBT) score of not less than 113
  - or TOEFL Internet-Based (IBT) score of at least 30.
  - Or IELTS score of at least 3.5.
  - Or, the English language proficiency test STEP from the National Center for Assessment with a score of no less than 68.
7. Have a valid occupational classification from the Saudi Commission for Health Specialties [for health specialties only].
8. To successfully pass any test or personal interview deemed necessary by the College Council.
9. To be medically fit.
10. To obtain approval to study from his employer, if he works in any government or private institution.
11. Submit the required documents specified by the College Admission and Registration Department.
12. Fill out the admission file.
13. Pay the registration fees.
14. Admission is made through differentiation among students according to the rates and conditions required to enroll in the major (note that the priority of enrollment is for students of high school graduates)

### Required documents ((postgraduate diploma graduates)):

1. The original high school transcript or equivalent.
2. Original certificate of good conduct.
3. Two recent colored photographs, 4 x 6 (boys only).
4. Two copies of the civil status card or the residence permit and the passport for non-Saudis, with the original residence permit for matching, which are recent and clear.
5. The original of the graduation document.
6. Original of academic transcript.
7. Original of the cooperative / excellence training certificate.
8. Original professional classification certificate (for health specialties only).
9. Original of the English language test result (for health majors only).
10. Bring written approval from the employer if the applicant is an employee.



## Transferring from another university to Buraydah colleges

### Procedures for admitting students transferred from another university to Buraydah colleges:

1. Student documents are examined to ensure that the conditions for transfer to the colleges and the specialization desired are met.
2. The student is given an admission file.
3. The student makes a medical examination.
4. A personal interview is made for the student.
5. The student's acceptance and approval of the transfer form from the previous university are approved.
6. The student submits a copy of the transfer approval to the previous university, clears one of its parties, and prepares his file and the original certificates.
7. The student in the fund pays the registration fee of 2500 riyals.
8. He submits his file to the Admission Department [Original of the secondary certificate - a stamped academic record - a copy of the ID card - a copy of the ability and achievement tests - 2 recent personal photos (boys only)].
9. The student is confirmed and a university number obtained.
10. A copy of his academic record is sent to the department in which the student is registered to make an equivalent to the previous university's decisions on the electronic system.
11. A student Timetable is downloaded.

### The documents required for transfer from another university to Buraydah colleges:

1. The original high school certificate.
2. A copy of the aptitude test.
3. A copy of the achievement test.
4. A copy of the academic record of the previous university.
5. Transfer form from the previous university.

1. The student pays 2500 riyals upon registration, which is calculated as a payment of the fees, then pays the rest of the amount in installments, provided that he pays the full semester fees before downloading a schedule for the next semester.
2. The support provided by the college to the student continues throughout the period of his study, provided that he is regular in payment, and the support stops in the event of irregularity or the student receiving a scholarship from outside the colleges.
3. In the event that the semesters are modified to three semesters in one academic year as required by the organizing rules of the Ministry of Education, the student will bear the payment of the additional financial costs according to the number of hours added, the semesters, or the time modification in the study plans and any obligations arising therefrom.
