








Admission Mechanism and Criteria for Master of Law Tracks

First	Program Tracks:
	1. The course of the law.
	2. Private Law Track.
	3. Public Law Track.
Second	Admission Criteria:
	1. Obtain a bachelor's degree in the specialization of [Law, Regulations, Law, or Sharia] or its equivalent.
	2. The average of the applicant in the bachelor's degree should not be less than (3.00 out of 5.00), or (2.50 out of 4.00), and an exception can be made if the applicant meets conditions accepted by the Standing Committee for Graduate Studies.
	3. The applicant must have a result in the General Aptitude Test for Universities during or before the application period, which is held by the National Center for Measurement and Evaluation.
	4. The applicant must obtain two scientific recommendations from professors who have previously taught him, or from an employer in which he has held a job for at least one year.
	5. Passing the personal interview.
	6. Passing the differentiation test.










Thirdly	Required Documents:
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Copy of the ID card, or Iqama and passport (for non-Saudis).▪ Bachelor's degree from an accredited university, with a grade of (3.00 out of 5.00), or (2.50 out of 4.00), and an exception to this can be made if the applicant meets conditions accepted by the Standing Committee for Graduate Studies.▪ Academic record for the undergraduate level.▪ The two scientific recommendations.▪ Biography.▪ The result of the General Aptitude Test for Universities.
Fourth	Admission and Registration Procedures:
1	Announcing the opening of admissions .
	The colleges announce the opening of applications for the master's program through the official website.
2	Submit the online application

3	Checking that the conditions are met
	The Admission Department conducts a preliminary review of the initial admission applications submitted to verify their conformity with the statutory and academic requirements, and the applicants are selected and sent an initial acceptance letter.
4	Conducting the differentiation test:
	Applicants undergo a written exam organized by the College of Administrative and Humanities Sciences, which aims to measure scientific and cognitive proficiency in the required specialization.
5	Interview:
	Applicants who pass the differentiation test are invited to conduct a personal interview with the college's interview committee, with the aim of assessing academic and research aspects, and the ability to adhere to graduate requirements. Bring the originals of the certificates and the required documents.
6	Final Trade-off :
	The process of differentiating applicants is conducted based on the weights of the following criteria: 1. The cumulative average for the bachelor's degree, (50%). 2. The result of the general aptitude test for university students, by (20%). 3. The result of the differentiation test, by (30%). 4. Pass the personal interview.
7	Announcement of the final admission results:
	The admission committee releases the results, and the accepted candidates are notified via text messages.
8	Completion of Admission and Registration Procedures:





	<p>The student who is finally accepted completes the following procedures:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">▪ Completing the academic file data.▪ Signing the declaration of the bunkerfor .▪ The payment of the admission fee (5000 five thousand riyals) <u>is non-refundable</u>, otherwise the student's admission will be considered canceled.▪ Registration for the courses.
9	Start of the study:
	The accepted student begins his studies in the program according to the university calendar of the colleges.
Fifthly	Tuition Fees:
	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Number of program semesters (4 semesters).• Fees for one semester (20000 Twenty Thousand Riyals).• The admission fee (5000 five thousand riyals) <u>is non-refundable</u> , otherwise the student's admission will be considered canceled.• Admission fees are calculated as part of the semester fees.• The rest of the fees are paid throughout the semester.• The full semester fees are paid before downloading a schedule for the next semester.• The total tuition fees of the program (80000 Eighty Thousand Riyals).
